**Eligibility criteria:**

1. Presenter should be one of the authors
2. Must be registered for the conference

**Judges:**

1. Will be selected by the committee, Judges will be notified after the selection.

**Selection Criteria:**

- Presentation will be reviewed and judged based on the criteria described below. Each paper will be given a score of 0 – 10 (where 0 is the lowest and 10 is the highest score) against each criterion.
- Where two or more papers receive the same total score, the following criteria will be looked at until a winner is found.
  1. Presentation skills > Winner, If not, Next criteria
  2. Completing on time > Winner, If not, Next criteria
  3. Quality and information on the slide> Winner, If not, Next criteria.
  4. Age of the presenter, Younger wins!

**Eligibility criteria:**

1. Presenter should be one of the authors
2. Must be registered for the conference
3. Timing of judges visit to poster area will be informed well ahead of time, if the author is not present, Poster will not qualify for the prize.
4. Will be given specified time to speak about their work – 5 minutes.

**Judges:** Will be selected by the committee, Judges will be notified after the selection.

**Selection Criteria:**

- Presentation will be reviewed and judged based on the criteria described below. Each paper will be given a score of 0 – 10 (where 0 is the lowest and 10 is the highest score) against each criterion.
- Where two or more papers receive the same total score, the following criteria will be looked at until a winner is found.
  1. Presentation skills > Winner, If not, Next criteria
  2. Completing on time > Winner, If not, Next criteria
  3. Quality and information on the slide > Winner, If not, Next criteria.
